

# Environmental Awareness Easter Homework.

- ◆ **Make a meal from left overs or 'throw away food'.** This could be something traditional like bread pudding from stale bread, banana bread from brown bananas or for something a little different visit <https://lovefoodhatewaste.com> .
- ◆ **Show evidence of you helping sort the recycling at home and explain what can go in the recycling bin .** A useful website is <https://www.thurrock.gov.uk/household-waste-and-recycling/what-goes-in-your-bins>.

- ◆ **Help someone clear out and donate old clothes or products to a charity.** Although charity shops are currently closed, there are still ways in which you can donate. Clothing donation bins are available throughout the borough and some charities like the British Heart foundation are offering a free postal service (<https://www.bhf.org.uk/shop/donating-goods/post-your-donations>).
- ◆ **Give some 'throw away packaging' a second life by changing its use.** This could be making old tins into a pencil holder, plastic bottles into self-watering plant pots etc.
